Post Operative Instructions

- 1. Discomfort is expected to worsen over the next three days. On the fourth day, symptoms usually start to improve. Do NOT restore tooth until pain is gone.
- 2. Call Dr. Bui if you experience any of the following:
 - Infection
 - Bruising
 - Swelling
 - Numbness or tingling after 24 hours
 - Pain persisting or worsening after 2 weeks
- 3. Follow post operative Instructions as follows:
 - If an antibiotic was prescribed, take as directed on bottle label
 - Take Ibuprofen 600 mg three times a day for at least the first three days
 - Avoid chewing until numbness is gone and sensation has returned to normal
 - Do not chew on hard or sticky foods to avoid damage to temporary filling
 - If the filling should fall out return to office immediately to replace
 - Return to general dentist for continuation of treatment
